Make an articulated snake that can wriggle. Here are some examples for inspiration:

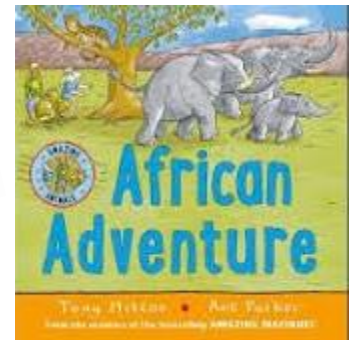


Listen to the story 'African Adventure' by Tony Mitten and Ant Parker.

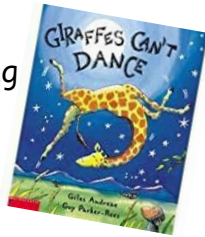
Maybe you could go on your own African Adventure?
