This week our topic is 'Under the sea creatures'

Make an ocean in an egg box. You could include drawings of creatures that live under the sea, shells, seaweed. Be as imaginative as you like.



Under the sea paper plate challenge

Using one paper plate, make an under sea creature. Which under the sea creature will you make? What will you use?



Have a look in your story book collection at home. Do you have any about Under the sea creatures? Spend some time looking at the pictures and making up your own story based on what you see happening before reading them with a grown up or sibling.



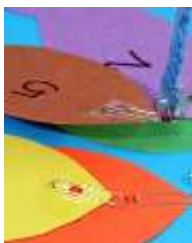
Sea shell funky finger activity

You will need card sea shells with numbers 1-10 on them and clothes pegs. Make your card sea shells, this could be by printing the shells on the page below and sticking onto card or make your own.

Using your pinching thumb and finger, squeeze the pegs and peg on the correct number to match the number on the shell.



Fish for it!



Make up a fishing game. Cut out fish shapes and attach a paperclip to one end. You could write letters on the fish or numbers or even this week's words.

When you catch a fish with your magnet, you have to read the word or think of a word beginning with that letter or count out that number of objects and compare two sets.
