Speech bubbles

Model writing the following sentence on a straight line. You could use the templates below if you like or draw your own speech bubble with a straight line inside to write on. Form the letters slowly talking about where you start and finish.

I left that trail of old stones.

Remind children where to start letters and to leave a space between words. You could make the space bigger to accentuate the point.

Draw a line for your child to write on and encourage them to write the sentence themselves, repeating the words one at a time as often as necessary and sounding out slowly to support their use of phonics e.g th-a-t.

If your child finds writing challenging you could focus just on the HFWs and ai word (I, that, of, old). If they need more support use a yellow felt tip pen to write the sounds for the words as you sound them out together. They can then go over the letters using their pencil.
