'or' Zig Zag books


Choose one of the chilli challenges below to make a book of 'or' words.

If you are unable to print you can use an a4 piece of plain paper, fold it following the instructions below (not number 1) and draw the pictures on.

	Write the initial sound for each word under the picture. Adults, please say the word slowly to help your child identify the initial sound. You may need to isolate the sound to help, for example 'p-ort'. If your child finds letter formation a challenge, write the letter of the sound they have identified, for them in yellow or a light coloured felt pen for them to trace over. Please only use lowercase.
	Say the 'or' word slowly to match the picture on each page. Write the word in the phoneme frame underneath. Remember, one sound goes into each box. 'or' is one sound as it is a digraph so would go in one box rather than 2. Your child should try to do this independently, you could repeat the word for them to help them segment.
	Say the 'or' word slowly to match picture on each page. Write the letters of the sounds you hear on the line underneath each picture. This should be done as independently as possible.


To fold your zig zag book follow the instructions below:

1. Cut along the outer edges (dotted lines), the row with the chilli challenge symbol can be cut off.
2. Fold the paper long ways in half so you can see the pictures.
3. Fold in half again, meeting the 2 short sides together, the front of the book should not be visible.
4. Fold one of the open-ended sides back to join the folded edge.
5. Turn over and fold the other side back to meet the fold



This will create the 'zig zag' book and should show pictures on both sides.



