Maths

L.O – To learn the number bond chant and show how many ways you can to make 10.

You will now be getting really familiar with pairs of numbers that make 10. You might not even have to count them all the time.

Chant this rhyme together to remember the number bonds to 10.

Show each number with your fingers.



Number Bonds rhyme

5 and 5 they add to 10,

6 and 4 make 10 again.

7 and 3 they make 10 too,

Guess what? So do 8 and 2!

9 and 1, 10 and 0,

Learn them all, be a number bond hero!



Next play a game with the number cards below or make your own, finding pairs of numbers to make 10. You could give one number to each teddy and match them up to make 10. You can use counters and a 10 frame to help.

1	2	3	4	5	0
6	7	8	9	5	10

Now make or draw number bonds to 10 in any way you choose. You could use real life objects or counters in a 10 frame. You could draw lots of 10 frames and draw coloured spots to represent all the ways to make 10. You might like to use the part, part, whole model to show number bonds to 10.

How many ways can you make 10?

What number could you start with? Put it in the 10 frame. How many more do you need? What are the 2 groups which make 10? Can you say it in a number sentence? What if you start with one more?

How many **different ways** can you show number bonds to 10? How many different pairs of numbers to 10 do you know? Have you found them all? How can you check? Encourage your child to be methodical, start with 1 and 9 then 2 and 8.
