Talk about your ideas with your grown up.

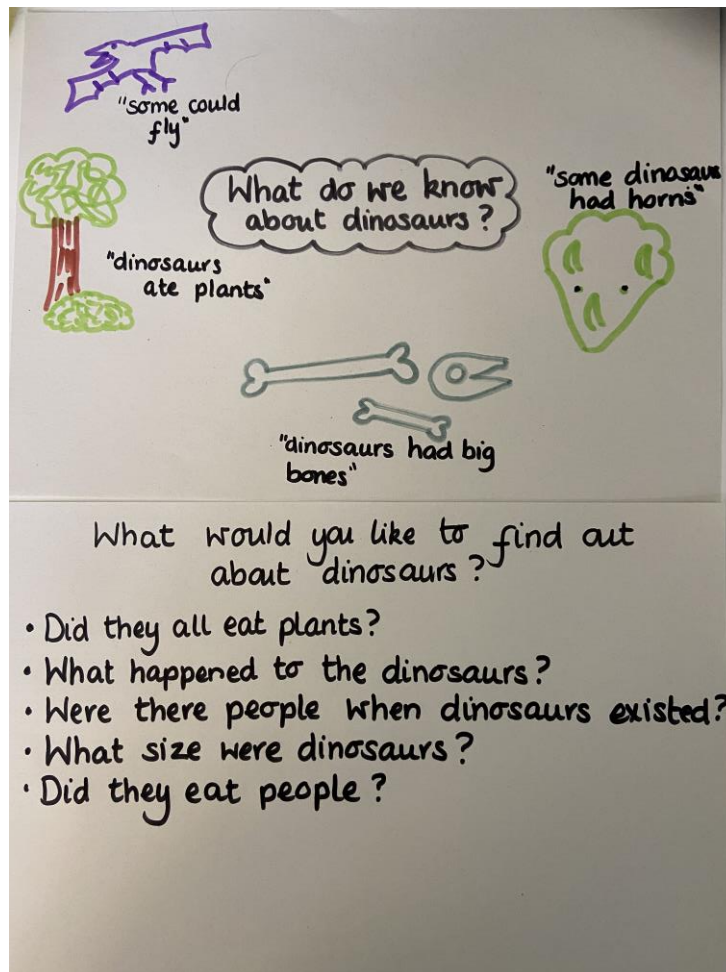


This week we are starting our 'Discovering Dinosaurs' Topic.
