So how could you begin?

You could set the scene by telling your reader about your character.

You could start in the middle of an action e.g. The heavy front door finally opened and...

Maybe your character could be talking e.g. "I'm going outside and I may be sometime", explained Esteban to Duncan.

You could start with a statement e.g. No one would ever expect a crayon to go on an adventure, but...
