Tips for your writing:

1. Remember to think about your sentence first, say it out loud a few times to help remember it and then write it down.
2. Use your sound mat and teddy book to help you write your sentences.
3. For those children who find identifying the sounds a challenge, encourage them to write the sounds they can hear, adults can write the rest of the word above for them to copy below.
4. Don't forget to use finger spaces and full stops.
5. Once you have written your sentence, use your sounds to blend the words you have written to check they say what you were planning.
