This week in Maths we are revisiting money. Your task for today is to go around your house and collect coins (these must be current UK). Remember to check first before collecting them and make sure they go back to the correct people at the end of this

activity. You could choose to use the money in your piggy bank if you have one.

Using the coins you have collected, sort them out into piles of the same coin.

Once you have done this have a go at the below suggestions:

1. Can you choose 2 different coins and find one thing that is the same about them?
2. Can you choose 2 different coins and find something that is different about them?
3. Choose a coin, explain to another member of your family how you know it is 1p/2p/5p/10p/20p/50p/£1/£2.
4. Can you put the coins in order of value?
5. Can you put the coins in size order?
6. Can you play 'I'm thinking of a coin'? with a member of the family? For this you will need to choose one coin without telling anyone which one it is, describe what it looks like e.g. it is a circle, small and silver in colour. The person you have described it to will need to guess which coin they think you are thinking of. Take it in turns to play this.
