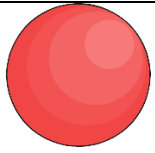
Once you have looked at this, you are going to become a '3D Shape Detective'. You can dress up as a detective if you like!

Choose from the chilli challenges below:

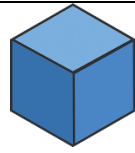

|  Hot | Find as many objects as you can and draw/write what you found in the box. For each object you found explain to an adult at home how you know what you found is a sphere/cube/pyramid/cuboid/cylinder/cone |

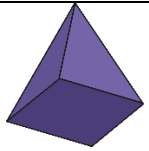

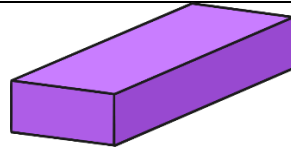
Sphere



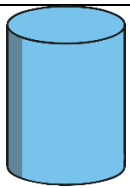
Cube



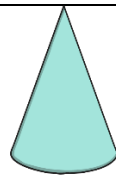
Pyramid
