Choose from the below chilli challenges:

 <p><b>Mild</b></p>	<p>Draw a picture and <b>write 1 sentence</b>. Write the initial sound for each word, your adult can write the rest of the word on the line above for you to copy underneath. See if you can listen for any other sounds too, write the ones you can hear. Be careful to form your letters correctly.</p>
 <p><b>Spicy</b></p>	<p>Draw a picture and <b>write 2 sentences</b>. Use your sounds and teddy book to write the words in your sentence. You will need to say words slowly to help listen for the order of the sounds. Be careful to form your letters correctly and remember finger spaces.</p>
 <p><b>Hot</b></p>	<p>Draw a picture and write <b>at least 3 sentences</b>. Use your sounds and teddy books to help. Remember for longer words you will need to say the words slowly or break them down into smaller chunks. You will need to read back your writing, sounding and blending each word to check it makes sense. Be careful to form your letters correctly, so they sit on the line. Don't forget finger spaces and full stops.</p>
