Before school closed, we had a go at writing an acrostic poem about a chosen animal.

Can you write an acrostic poem about a habitat?

Here is an example:

Dry, sandy dunes

Everywhere are cacti

Sunshine all around

Everyone is hot

Roads are covered in dust

Tiny creatures scuttle under rocks for shelter



You can choose any habitat you like.

If you find writing an acrostic a bit too tricky, you can write a description of a habitat instead, if you like.

Here is an example:

A desert is a barren area of landscape where little rain falls and so it is very dry all year round. Living conditions are difficult for plant and animal life as it is so hot, but certain plants and animals can be found in deserts, such as cacti, lizards, scorpions and camels.
