Eventually the knight found a huge pile of hay and a cosy blanket in the stables.

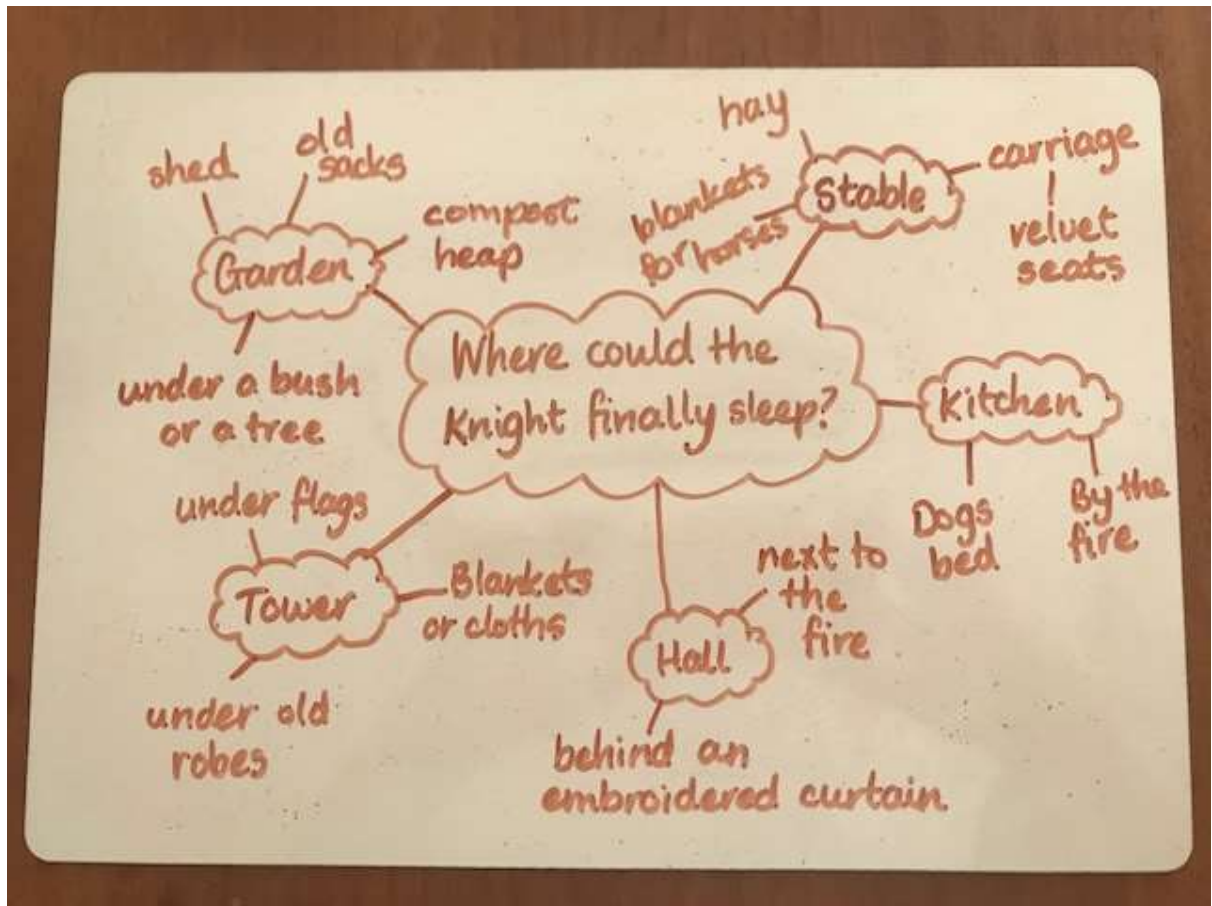
"This looks comfy" sighed the Knight and he scrambled onto the hay, pulling the blanket over him. Soon he was fast asleep.
