Nicole Mauruzi da Tolentino at The Battle of San Romano (1438-40)

By Paolo Uccello (1397-1475) Italian born in Lucca - buried in Florence. A Renaissance painter in the 1400s

Find out about the painting.

What is it about? Who is the person in the red hat?

How many types of hat can you see in Uccello's painting? Could you design a hat as magnificent as the red one? (Don't forget to label it)

What would you hear, see, smell or feel if you were there?

Make a list of these things and decorate it or maybe create a mood board.

Ask if you can use objects in your kitchen as instruments and create a piece of music to go with the picture. You could use your recorder too.



Maybe you could record it and send it to your teacher.

Look carefully at the fabrics. What patterns can you see? What pattern would you have on your fabric? Have a go at painting your pattern on paper or fabric.

Can you see the different armour?

If you were in the picture, what would your armour look like?
