

## Task 1 - W.B. 01.06.20

Make a number line to 20, you will need a strip of paper and some colouring pencils or pens. Ask a grown up to help you use a ruler to draw a line and make sure the numbers are spaced out equally. Start by answering these questions. Can you count along your number line in 2's and 5's? What number is in the middle? Can you find your age on your number line?

Now you will need to choose 2 numbers on your number line, you could use number cards to 20 that you made before half term or a dice to help you pick the numbers. Now you need to work out the difference between the 2 numbers you chose.

Start on the smaller number and count the jumps to other number. Use this video to help you

You can repeat this activity 5 times. What was the biggest number you picked? What was the smallest? What was the biggest difference between 2 numbers?

e.g. I picked 2 and 9, I started at 2 and counted 7 jumps to get to 9 so the difference between 2 and 9 is 7.
