English

-  Can you write detailed instructions for how to plant a seed and look after it as it grows?
-  Write a story with a beginning, middle and end about a tiger. Remember to write ‘Golden Sentences’ and to use connectives to make your sentences longer. Add lots of description too!
-  Find a picture and think of as many adjectives to describe the things in the scene e.g people, places, animals.
-  Choose one or two of your buzz words and see how many you can find in your books at home. Write sentences with them.

Maths

-  Imagine you have 3 coins in your purse. Investigate how much money you could have.
-  Choose a shape. Describe the shape to your partner for them to draw but don’t let them see the shape. Not as easy as it sounds!
-  Find a number that satisfies a criteria e.g. greater than 84, less than 70, greater than 75 but less than 87, with 5 tens and less than 8 ones- how many possibilities are there?
-  Investigate finding half of groups of objects. Can you find half of an odd number? Why?
