Do you remember your learning about 'expanded noun phrases'?

This is an example of a noun phrase:

the boy

We can expand it by adding detail using an adjective.

e.g. ***the kind boy***

You could use more adjectives.

e.g. ***the kind, happy boy.***



If you use more than one adjective, you will need to use a comma between the adjectives.

We would like you to expand these noun phrases by adding adjectives. You can expand all of them or choose ten.

the pool	a bag
a car	the prince
the koala	the princess
the stairs	a toad
a book	a road
the glasses	the treasure
the troll	a picnic
a shop	a tissue
a pencil	the teacher
the bike	a baby
