Today we are focusing on sentence types.

Remember, there are **four** types of sentence:

1. **statement** - a fact.
2. **question** - needs an answer.
3. **command** - tells someone what to do.
4. **exclamation** - exclamations begin with 'what' or 'how' and are **not** questions. They have an exclamation mark at the end.
A statement could also have an exclamation mark at the end but this is not technically classed as an exclamation sentence because an exclamation has to start with 'what' or 'how'.

TASK 1 - Decide which is which.
