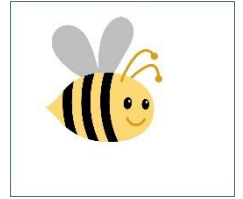

THIS WEEK WE ARE HAVING A FOCUS ON GRAMMAR.



Let's revise our knowledge about the **possessive apostrophe**.

We use the possessive apostrophe to show that something belongs to someone, e.g. I like your sister's new hula hoop. The hula hoop belongs to your sister, so the word 'sister' needs an apostrophe and then an 's'.

We do not need to use an apostrophe for plural words (something of which there is more than one), e.g. sandwiches

✓ sandwiches

x sandwiches's
