Ordinal Numbers

This week in Maths we are learning about ordinal numbers.



We use ordinal numbers to identify an item/persons position in a list or line up.

Ordinal Numbers are used to show the order people finish in races.

You could make some rosettes to award to the people/toys who take part in your races.



1. Have a running race. Decide the start and finish line. Who came first? Who came second? You could change the type of race you have e.g. egg and spoon, hopping.



2. Flap the fish race- Cut out fish shapes from paper. You could decorate these. Each member of your family needs one fish and rolled up newspaper or a sheet of cardboard to flap to create a breeze to make their fish move. All start at the same place. What order have you all finished in?
