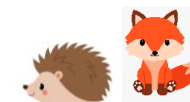

Make woodland animals using toilet roll tubes. Here is some inspiration

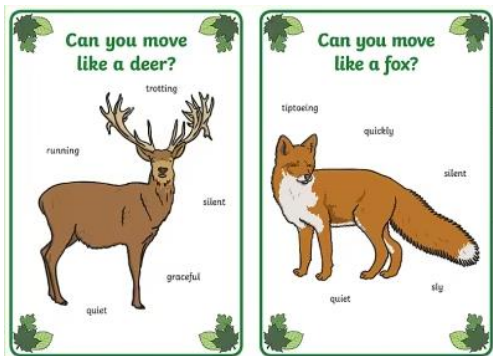


Make a bird feeder to encourage wildlife to your garden
