Phonics

L.o To write sentences using 'ee' words

Today you will be writing 'ee' words. Some of you might be able to write sentences with 'ee' words in.

 <p>Mild</p>	Write the initial sound of 'ee' words using a phoneme frame to match the picture. Say the word slowly and listen really hard for the initial sound.
 <p>Spicy</p>	Use the phoneme frame to write 'ee' words that match the picture. Say the word and listen for the initial sound. Repeat the word slowly to hear the next sound. Grown-ups may need to help to accentuate the sounds within the word e.g t-ee-th. There are sound buttons to help you on the trickier words.
 <p>Hot</p>	Grown-up to read the sentence from the list to your child. Read again counting the number of words on your hand or place one counter on the table for each word. Now concentrate on one word at a time. Say the word, child repeats. They may know how to write the word straight away. If not, repeat the word slowly so your child can identify the sounds and write them down. Don't worry if they confuse c/k or miss out a sound but focus on getting the 'ee' sound correct.

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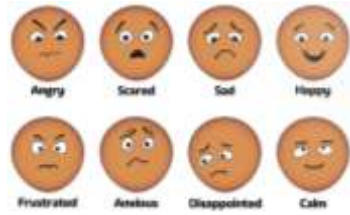

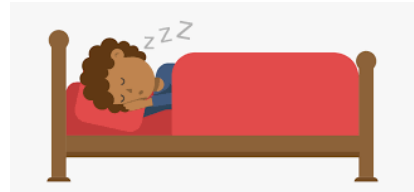
