Dear Parents,

We welcomed back Reception on 8th June and Year 1's joined us this week. The children have been amazing, adapting to the new safety regimes and it has been lovely to hear laughing children around the school.

The children seem to like their new desks with all their personal resources and, of course, the extra playtimes they are having.

I am sure you will join me in thanking the staff for making the return to school a smooth and happy one.

Some Reminders:

1. Please do not bring your child to school if they are ill for any reason. If the teacher becomes ill during this time, the group will need to close because of staffing capacity. If any house member develops coronavirus symptoms, you should call the school to inform us and follow the national Stay at Home guidance. Dial 999 if a family member becomes seriously ill.
2. Please bring a coat on chilly days and hat for the sunny ones. Children may bring a morning snack of fruit or vegetables. In addition, please can your child bring their own box of tissues. We will let you know when we need a replacement.
3. **One parent** with their child, must arrive and leave by your allocated time slot, find a white spot and move forward as space becomes available. Please leave promptly. Parents may not pick up other children from other families. The only exceptions are professional childminders.
